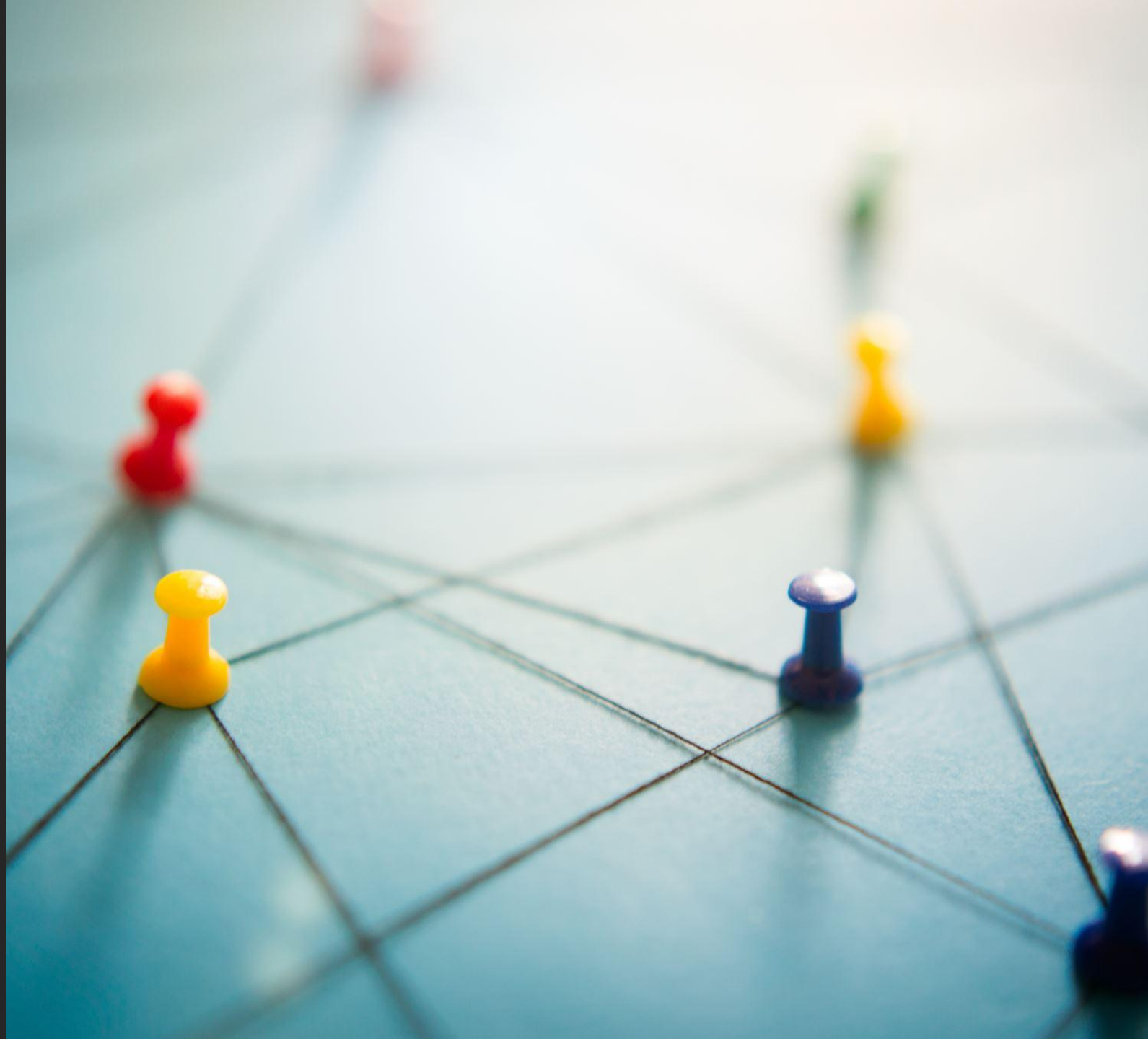

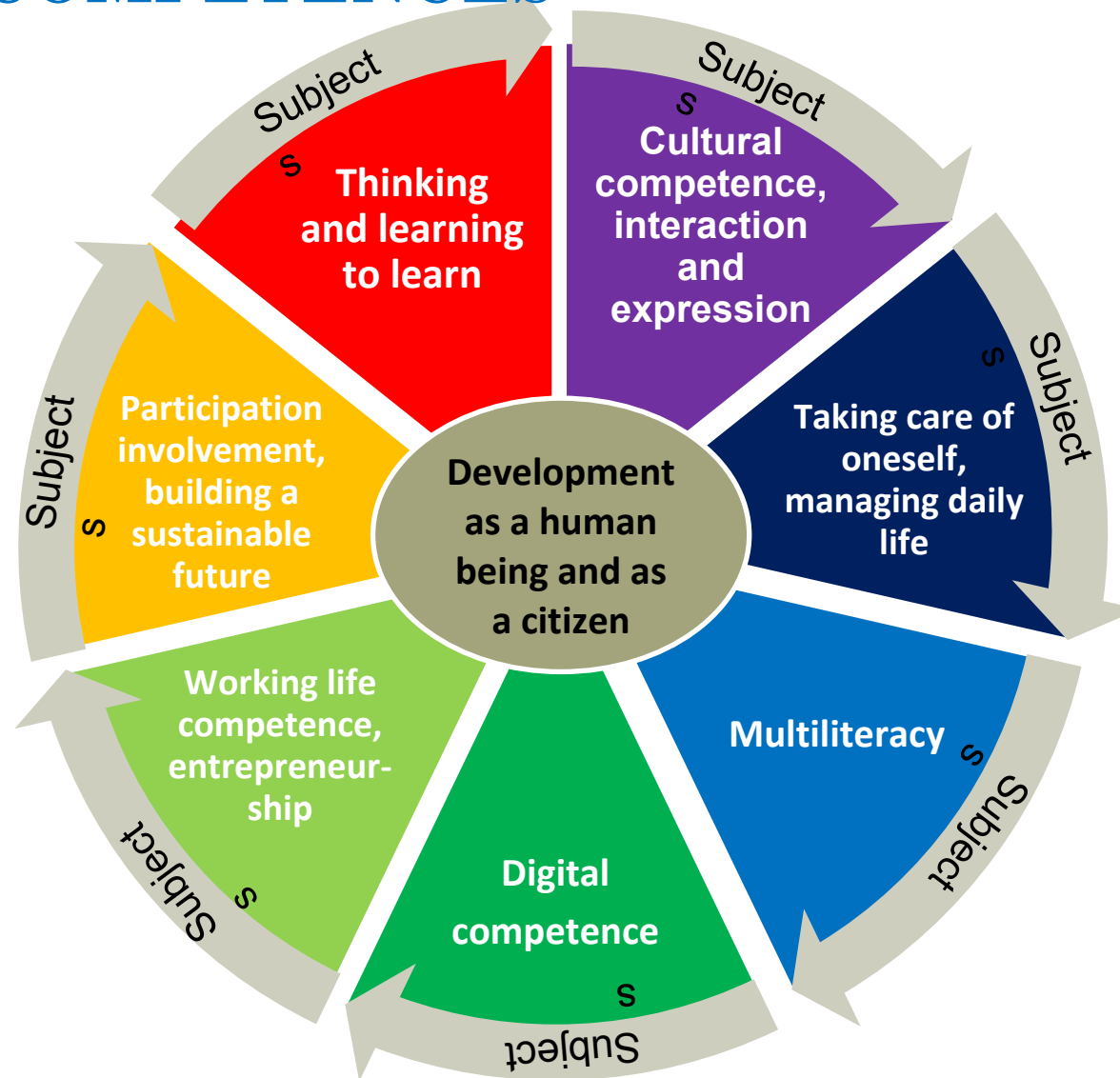
Joy of learning and learning motivation:

Strong basis for lifelong learning and well-being

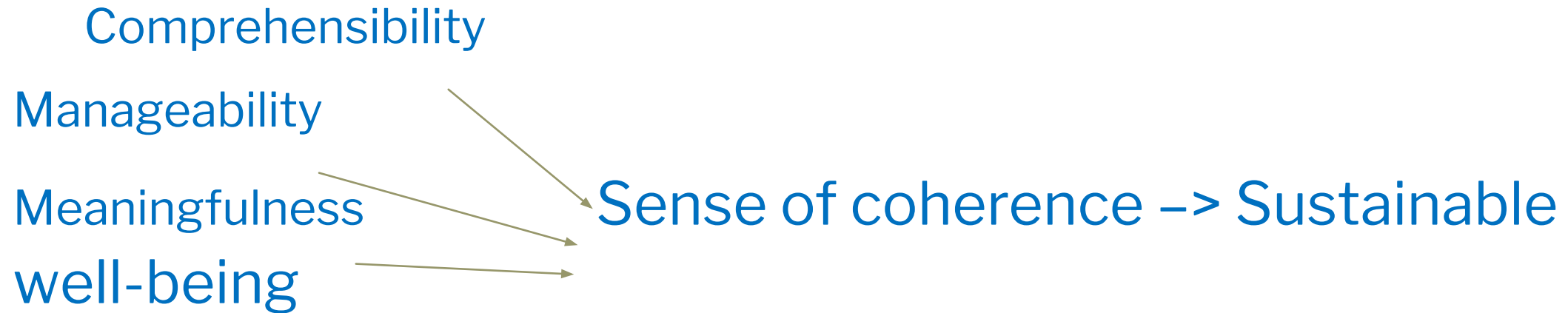
